#### Consider Approving Resolution No. 11, Series of 2022 - Garfield County FMLD Grant

City Manager Tommy Klien presented Resolution No. 11, Series of 2022 – Garfield County Federal Mineral Lease District Grant. A roundabout and pedestrian improvement project for the Whiteriver and HWY 6 intersection is at the design stage with the hopes to begin construction as early as fall of 2023. Staff estimates that the project will cost between \$5,000,000 and \$6,000,000. There is a possibility that the project will exceed our cost estimate due to the uncertainty in the construction market. Staff is requesting Councils approval to allow the city manager to apply for the FMLD grant, sign agreements related to the grant, and expend up to \$1,000,000 in matching funds.


