Consider Declaring Vehicle as Surplus and Donate to Animal Shelter

Chief of Police Tommy Klein explained that the Police Department has a 2004 Ford Freestar van that the City no longer uses because it was replaced with a new van in 2020. Rifle Municipal Code states that the City's personal property purchased for more than ten thousand dollars must be declared surplus by the City Council. Staff recommends the 2004 Ford Freestar van be declared as surplus and donated to the Rifle Animal Shelter.

Councilor Theresa Hamilton moved to declare the 2004 Ford Freestar van as surplus and donate the vehicle to the Rifle Animal Shelter with the appropriate legal documents; seconded by Councilor Joe Carpenter.

CLETA program

Chief of Police Tommy Klein explained that the Police Department has a 2013 Ford Explorer SUV that the City no longer uses because it has been replaced. Rifle Municipal Code states that the City's personal property purchased for more than ten thousand dollars must be declared surplus by the City Council. Staff recommends the 2013 Ford Explorer SUV van be declared as surplus and donated to

the Colorado Mountain College for use in the Colorado Law Enforcement Training Academy.

Councilor Theresa Hamilton moved to declare the 2013 Ford SUV as surplus and donate the vehicle to the Colorado Mountain College CLETA program with appropriate legal documentation; seconded by Councilor Sean Strode.

Consider Letter of Support for Garfield County's 5-Star State Certification Program Application

City Manager Scott Hahn stated that Garfield County plans to apply for a variance with the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment to establish a 5-Star Certification Program. The 5-Star Certification Program helps businesses accelerate their reopening by implementing additional safety measures beyond what is currently required by Public Health Orders. Garfield County's application for variance requires letters of support from entities such as local hospitals, mayors, and emergency managers. Staff recommends support for Garfield County's 5-Star State Certification Program application.

Councilor Sean Strode moved to support the Garfield County 5-Star State Certification Program application for variance; seconded by Councilor Theresa Hamilton.

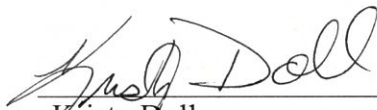

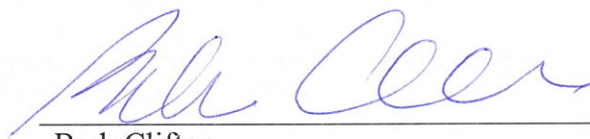
