Consider Garfield County Purchase Contract for Services – Senior Meal Preparation (Renewal 2)

Senior Center Director Tami Sours presented a request to consider the Garfield County purchase contract for services – Senior Meal Preparation (Renewal 2). This a renewal contract to extend the 2021 RFP for another twelve months (July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024) for senior meal preparation of the west end of the county that includes New Castle, Silt, Rifle and Parachute. The renewal contract will keep the reimbursement rate of \$11.50 per meal with an annual cap of \$196,650.00. Changes in staff and food ordering have significantly helped with maintaining meal rates. Staff recommends approval of Purchase Contract for Services – Senior Meal Preparation (Renewal 2).

Senior Center Director Tami Sours answered questions for Council.

Councilor Clint Hostettler moved to approve the purchase contract for services - Preparation of Senior Meals from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024 for New Castle, Silt, Rifle and Parachute; seconded by Councilor Joe Carpenter.

Consider Ordinance No. 12, Series of 2023 – Amending Section 6-5-170 of the Rifle Municipal Code to Update the Duration of a Responsible Service of Alcohol Certificate – 1st Reading

City Clerk Misty Williams presented a request to consider Ordinance No. 12, Series of 2023 – Amending Section 6-5-170 of the Rifle Municipal Code to Update the Duration of a Responsible Service of Alcohol Certificate – 1st Reading. Responsible Service of Alcohol certificates are required for any person who will be serving alcoholic beverages in establishments with a liquor license, including special events serving alcohol and tastings events. The RSA certificates are issued to persons who have completed the necessary training required by the State of Colorado Liquor Enforcement Division (LED), from a LED-approved training vendor. The State of Colorado LED modified the term limitations on Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) certificates at the beginning of the year. Previously, the RSA certificates were valid for three (3) years from the date of issuance. The new State of Colorado rule sets RSA certificates are now valid for a period of two (2) years from the date of issuance. In order to be compliant with LED's new RSA certificate valid period this ordinance will update City of Rifle's municipal code.

Councilor Alicia Gresley moved to approve Ordinance No. 12, Series of 2023 on 1st reading and order it to be published by title as required by Charter; seconded by Councilor Sean Strode.
