CONSIDER PROPOSAL FOR SCHEMATIC DESIGN OF SWIMMING POOL OPTION C

The pool project team; Parks and Recreation Director Tom Whitmore, Aquatics Coordinator James Vaughn Phil Vaughan of Phil Vaughan Construction Management and Jeff Johnson of Jeff Johnson Architects, P.C., explained at the last meeting Council directed staff to prepare a proposal for a third design option, "Option C", for the pool project that would stay within the 6 million dollar budget. The proposal for the swimming Pool "Option C" architectural work through the schematic design phase only is \$36,375.00.
